Local Area Coordination

Local Area Coordination has launched in Fulford and Heslington. The new Local Area Coordinator (LAC) in your area is Alice Hawken.

For those who are new to Local Area Coordination: it is an evidence-based approach to support you as a valued resident in your community. LACs work with individuals and families of all ages and abilities. They take time to get to know you, your family, friends, carers and your community, so they can help you to build a strong support network. This enables you to pursue your vision for a good life and to stay safe, strong, connected, healthy, and in control.



Support is offered to people who feel isolated and vulnerable due to age, frailty, disability or mental health needs or for any other reason(s). Residents can introduce themselves or be introduced to their LAC by anyone. The types of support offered by an LAC are but not limited to:

- helping you access a wide range of information
- identify and navigate complex health and social care systems
- develop relationships and community networks
- getting your voice heard about things that are important to you
- helping you find volunteering opportunities
- find practical ways of doing the things you want or need to do


