### Fulford Parish Council High Reserves Explanation 2023/2024

RESTATED

14/8/2014

Fulford Parish Council operates a cemetery (with an annual turnover in excess of £200,000) which, besides catering for the needs of parish residents, also provides burial facilities for the City of York residents through an Agreement with City of York Council. The Parish Council's Financial Regulations require a 3-12 months' running costs contingency to be maintained, this includes the running costs for the Cemetery. There is currently a 4.5 month running costs contingency included within the reserves. Under the terms of the Cemetery Agreement with City of York Council, any annual profit from the Cemetery has to be retained in a separate account named the Cemetery Development Fund, solely for capital expenditure at the Cemetery (and only where authorised by City of York Council). The balance of the Cemetery Development Fund is set out below. 80% of any deficit for the Cemetery will be funded by City of York Council with Fulford Parish Council funding the remaining 20% of that deficit. In 2023/2024 the Cemetery made a loss of £12,003,11.

Fulford Parish Council owns and manages a community venue known as Fulford Social Hall which currently requires significant repairs and renovations. Reserves totalling £50,000 have been earmarked towards match funding for a Community Ownership Fund grant application in respect of the renovation project and a further £14,391 has been earmarked towards the initial phase of the renovation project. Further funds will be required for the Social Hall as the project progresses. A contingency is also retained within the gerneral reserve for other unexpected expenses or new projects such as playground equipment/street furniture. Once the Parish Council has received £35,112.49 owed in respect of legal costs, cemetery deficit and grant funding (listed below) the general reserve will stand at £36,097.15 but until those funds are received, it stands at £1,184.66. £ 11,614.66 72.7K
