

# What is composting? Any organic material > Decomposition > Compost








### Compost containers?

## The Alchemy

#### **Green waste X 4 parts by volume**

WEEDS
Kitchen waste Uncooked?
Grass clippings
Green hedge clippings
Summer fleshy pruning/tidying
Tea leaves, coffee grounds

## The Alchemy

**Brown waste X l part by volume** 

Fine wood chip/old woodchip
Old leaves
Cardboard (plain)
Winter herbaceous pruning

- Any plastics
- Metal

 Cardboard or paper with shiny inks or multi-coloured

"Compostable plastic"?














# **Types of composting**
